The Australian and New Zealand Society of Occupational Medicine (ANZSOM) is pleased to announce the 2013 Annual Scientific Meeting to be held at Four Points Hotel on the waterfront at Geelong. GETTING THERE:

Avalon Airport is located a short drive from Geelong and is serviced by JetStar. Shuttle services operate from the airport to Geelong. Car hire is also available at both Tullamarine and Avalon Airports.

Are you up to date with your CPR?

Included in the conference registration is the opportunity to meet your CPR training requirements.

The CPR session counts for 2.5 hours of CPD; is accredited by RACGP and the certificates comply with AHPRA requirements.

The session includes theoretical as well as practical aspects including one and two rescuer techniques; optional advanced airway management using an intubating manikin and defibrillation use. The sessions will be conducted by Ian Cash member of the Victorian Branch of the Australian Resuscitation Council and workplace first aid and resuscitation trainer (Australasian SOS Oxygen & First Responder Training).
