## **Policy statement**

## Dealing with real or perceived conflicts of interest between the roles of Manager of SISA and a JP

## **Definition**

In setting this policy, I use the following description of 'conflict of interest' derived from the one set out on the Australian Health Practitioners Regulation Agency website:

Generally a conflict of interest may occur if an interest or activity influences the ability of a person to exercise objectivity or impairs their ability to perform their duty...

A conflict of interest may exist even if no unethical or improper act results. This is because a conflict of interest can create an appearance or perception of impropriety, which can undermine the integrity of the powers or functions to be exercised...

## <u>Policy</u>

- 1. To identify *potential* conflicts, I will seek key preliminary information from a person seeking my services as a JP what services are sought, by whom, are they in support of some form of litigation or adversarial action, and if so, who the parties are, and so on.
- 2. As both the Manager of SISA and a JP, I will consider myself conflicted and would decline to provide JP services where:
  - a) One member organisation of SISA seeks my services as a JP in respect of any legal action or business transaction involving another member organisation of SISA.
  - b) An individual employed by a member organisation of SISA seeks my services as a JP in any legal or other adversarial action involving that member organisation of SISA or another member organisation of SISA.
  - c) My JP services are sought by any organisation, whether or not a member organisation of SISA, in which I have any direct or indirect financial or other personal interest (for example, through employing a direct family member).
  - d) A member of the Executive Committee of SISA seeks my services as a JP in any matter involving a member organisation of SISA, another member of the Executive Committee of SISA, a staff member of SISA or an employee of a member organisation of SISA.
  - e) A member of my direct family seeks my services as a JP.
  - f) An organisation that provides personal financial services to me or a member of my direct family, or an employee thereof, seeks my services as a JP for any reason.
- 3. In any of the above circumstances or in any other like circumstances, I would decline to act as a JP where there was any:
  - real conflict of interest; or
  - a likelihood of a conflict being perceived by another person,

as defined above.
